MUTUAL RECOGNITION TREATY AND DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN

Principality of Ferthroy

and

State of Vishwamitra

- <u>Article 1</u> The two micronation signatories to this treaty undertake to recognize the existence, the validity and the sovereignty of their micronations.
- Article 2 The two signatories undertake to maintain a friendly diplomatic relationship between the two parties.
- <u>Article 3</u> The signatories of this treaty undertake to recognize the titles of nobility, the legitimacies and the public functions of their micronations.
- <u>Article 4</u> The signatory micronations commit to peace.
- <u>Article 5</u> The signature of this treaty admits a commitment for the radiance of the micronational world in the world.
- <u>Article 6</u> The two signatories undertake to guarantee a state of non-aggression between the two parties.
- <u>Article 7</u> This treaty authorizes the two parties to guarantee the same diplomatic relations with the other micronations.
- <u>Article 8</u> The two signatories undertake to support each other in the event of armed conflict. The two parties nevertheless pledge to respect military and political positions.
- Article 9 This present treaty can be published in the Official Gazettes of the signatories if they wish
